10th June 22 - Daniel: For amazing writing for the Queen's Jubilee Diary.

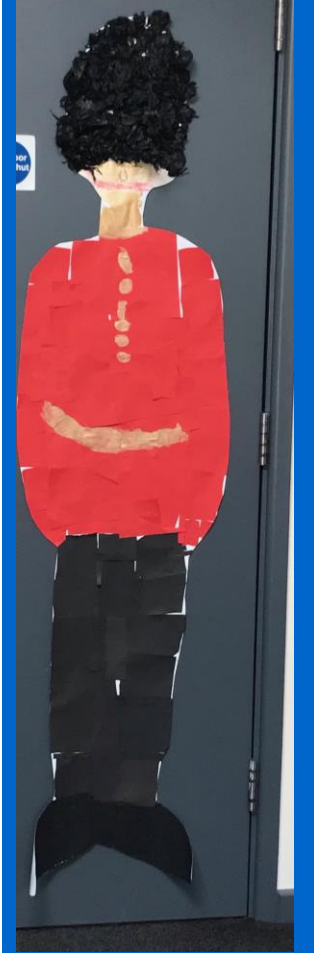
Hazel Class:

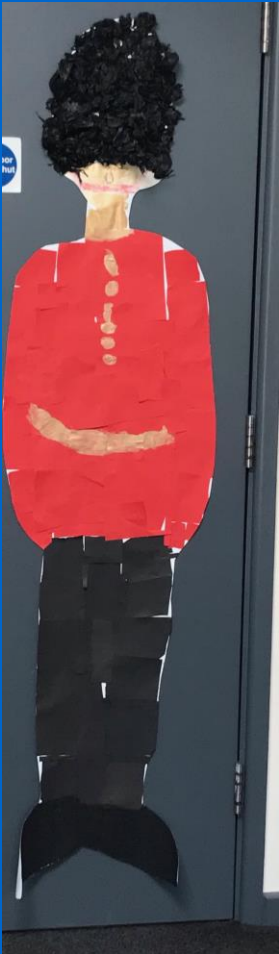




Cake Sale:

Our Mission Statement is at the heart of everything we do and we try to incorporate it into every aspect of our school life. Blessed Pauline Jaricot:

(22 July 1799 – 9 January 1862) Blessed Pauline Jaricot was a French member of the Third Order of Saint Dominic. She also was the founder of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith and the Association of the Living Rosary.

Pope John XXIII ratified the first step of her beatification process, declaring her venerable. On 26 May 2020, Pope Francis recognized a miracle attributed to her intercession as the final requirement for beatification.

Pauline Jaricot was a remarkable young lay woman with formidable faith.

Through her resolution and strong beliefs, she founded the Association for the Propagation of the Faith (the APF), which makes her one of Missio's founders.

Pauline believed that if we all give a little and pray together, we can share God's love throughout the world.

Blessed Pauline Jaricot was Beatified (made into a Saint) 22nd May 2022.

Prayer for Blessed Pauline Jaricot:

Venerable Pauline Jaricot, you who consecrated your life to spreading the Kingdom of Christ in serving God and His people, intercede for us and may God deign to give us the grace that we humbly ask for. Amen.
