WORLD BOOK DAY: Thursday 6th March

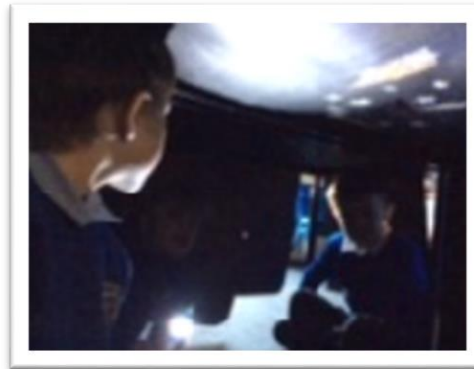
We are really looking forward to
