How have teddy bears changed in the last 100 years? An investigation into how our toys are different to toys our parents are grandparents played with. Using primary sources to explore.

Up and down (an action song), pupils will song songs in steps using accompanying actions, and will go on to compose new lyrics and play simple melodies on pitched instruments. Five fine bumble bees (a counting song) children will learn to sing the song in call-and-response, and there are opportunities for adding percussion and creating minibeast soundscapes. The activities in the unit are great for understanding changes in tempo and going on to responding to music through movement.
