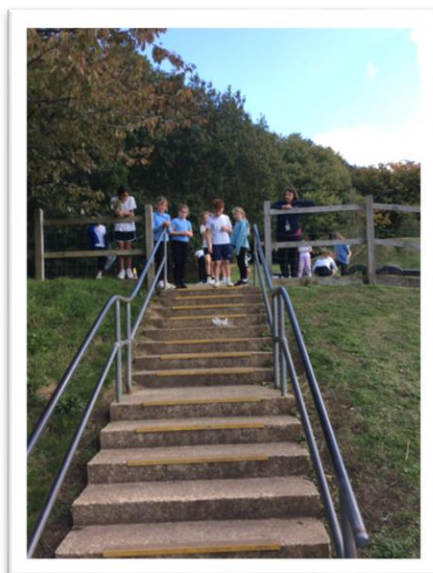
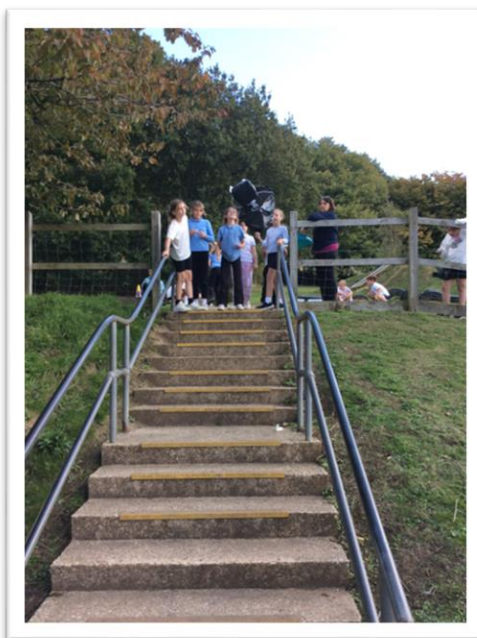
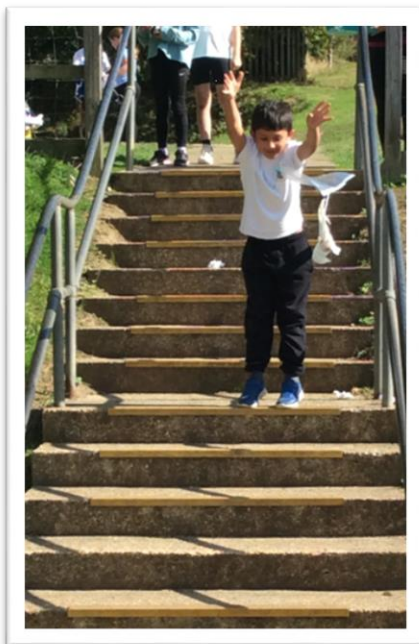
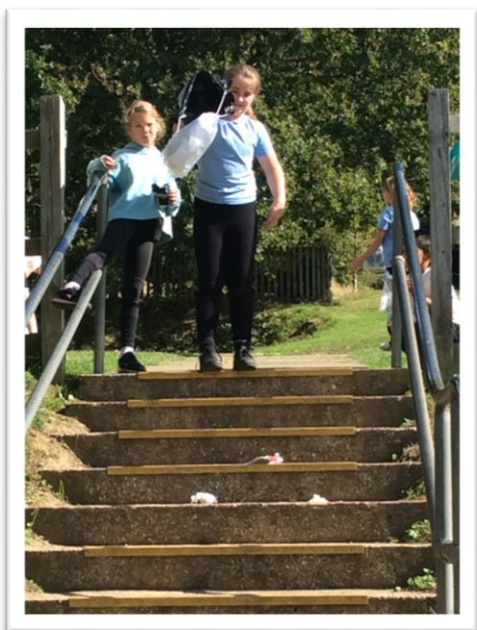
Maple Class Bird Feeders:
