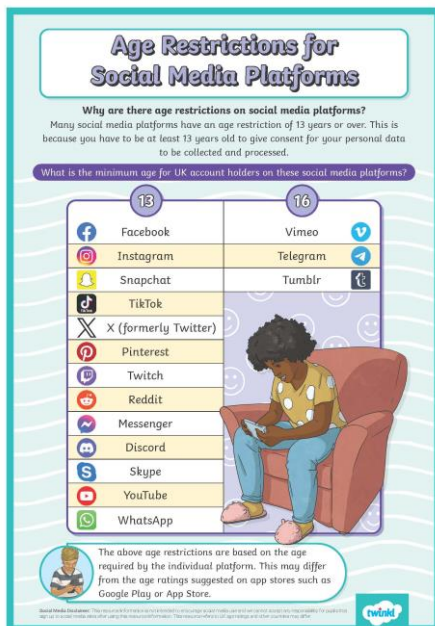
We are so proud of Gabriel, Kinga and Mikiel who are now servers on the altar.
