We will learn about how bread is made with the help of the Little Red Hen.

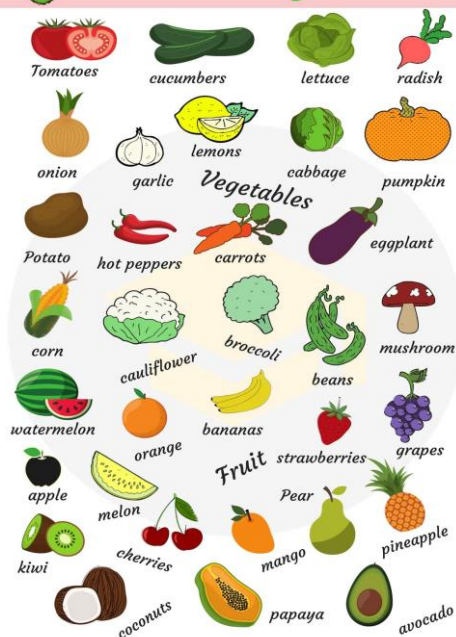
Finally, we will complete our topic by having a class feast. This is where we will bake bread and make soup and finish with carrot cake.

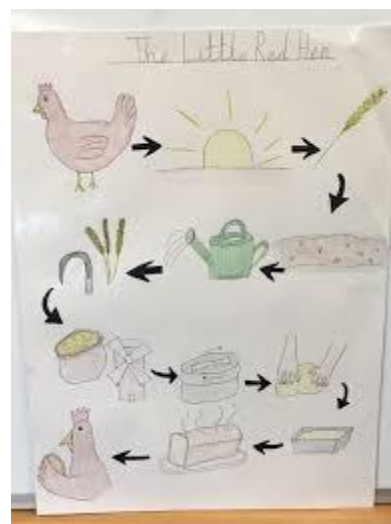


Fruit & Vegetables
